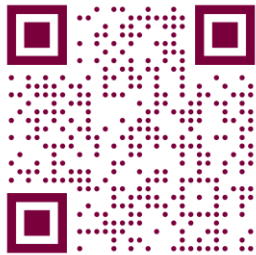

## The Canadian Obstetrics Survey System

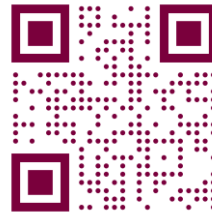


CanOSS is a group of Canadian investigators working towards the development and establishment of a Canada-wide survey system for pregnancy-related morbidity.

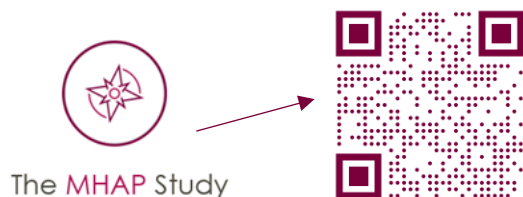
## The MHAP Study
